IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT UNEARTH PERTH

WHAT TO WEAR

When you arrive at The Esplanade you will need to be in full uniform. On the Saturday and Sunday you can either wear your uniform or your Unearth Perth Activity Shirt. On Monday at the Closing Ceremony you will again be required to wear your full uniform.

NO NUTS

Due to many people being highly allergic to Nuts, the entire event will be a nut free zone. This includes peanuts, peanut paste or butter and any other type of nuts and products containing nuts.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECKS

Any person over the age of 18 years **will** and **must** have a Working With Children Check if you are coming into the ASOC. There will be no exceptions to this rule. This includes Rovers who are over the age of 18 years.

FOOD FOR THE WEEKEND

Remember that this weekend is a self cater event so you will need to bring all you own food. There will be BBQ's and some gas ring burners for you to use in the kitchen area.

ICE

Ice orders will be taken on the Saturday morning to have ice delivered. If you would like to re-ice your esky at 6pm on Saturday night, and Sunday morning you can place an order at the Admin Tent.

LEAVING THE ASOC OUTSIDE OF CHECKOUT HOURS (must be before midnight)

Cubs and Joeys who are not staying over night will need to inform the Administration Officer prior to the weekend. Scouts, Venturers and Rovers will not be permitted to leave the ASOC except in the designated check-out times. Leaders will be able to leave the site up until midnight. After 10pm nobody will be able to enter the ASOC.

DROPPING OFF GEAR

Metro groups who would like to drop off gear prior to the event can do so on Friday the 30th of May between the hours of 6pm and 9pm. To do this please observe the following instruction. Vehicles must turn left into driveway onto the esplanade reserve off William Street. Follow the traffic cones and direction of arrows as shown on the site plan. Vehicles must be unloaded of participants and equipment as quickly as possible. Once unloaded, the vehicle must leave the site. This is a no parking zone. Please follow all instructions as given by event staff.



COUNTRY GROUPS

We have made arrangements for country groups to be able to stay on the Esplanade on the Friday night. You will be able to check into the site from 3pm on the 30th of May.

TENTS

Males and females must sleep in separate tents. Please make sure that your team or group has arranged for this. There will be no exceptions to this rule and anyone found in breach of this may be asked to leave the event.

FREE PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Over the weekend, the Public Transport Authority and Transperth have provided Scouts WA with free transport of all public buses, trains and ferries. To take advantage to this you must be either in your Scout Uniform, Guide Uniform, Cadet Uniform, or your Unearth Perth Activity Shirt. You must also be wearing your Unearth Perth Identification Card. This means that you will not have free transport into the City on the Saturday morning.

FUELS ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

You are not permitted to bring fuel of any sort onto public transport. If you are bringing hexi stove fuels, LPG, kerosene, and cooking fuels you will need to make alternate arrangements for getting these to and from The Esplanade.

FIRST AID KITS

Please ensure that you have a first aid kit for each team.

ALCOHOL, DRUGS, AND SMOKING

Unearth Perth is a alcohol and drug free event. Anyone who is found to have breach this will be sent home immediately. Smoking is not permitted at the event.

CONTACTING YOUR TEAM DURING THE EVENT

Each team should have at least one mobile phone per team. This is how Admin will contact your team while you are off The Esplanade.

FOOTWEAR

Please ensure that you are wearing appropriate, sturdy footwear for the weekend.
